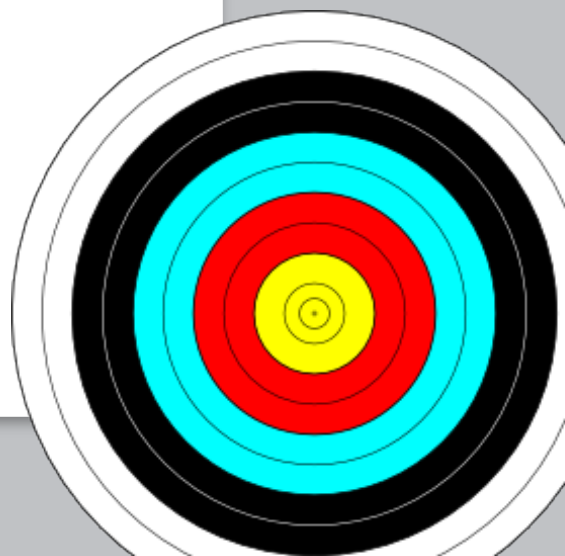

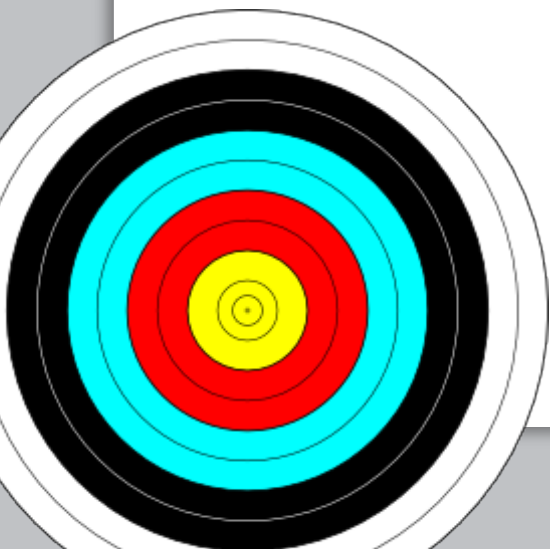
Good luck to Curtis as he starts his career in the RAF.
